Sample Disaster and Emergency Plan for Events held at Oriole Dog Training Club

AKC Policy for Emergency Procedures at Dog Events

1. Each club holding a member or licensed event must develop and detail a Disaster and Emergency Plan for that event. The Plan form must be completed and filed with AKC and will be considered a part of the event application.
2. Clubs must advise local authorities (police, fire department, medical services, etc.) of their event, including the exact location, ingress, egress and duration, within thirty days prior to the event.
3. All specialty clubs are strongly encouraged to have a qualified emergency medical technician (CPR certified) in attendance at each event.
4. At group and all-breed conformation events, clubs are required to have a qualified emergency medical technician (CPR certified) in attendance from one hour prior to the start of judging until completion of all judging.
5. A Red Cross-approved emergency first aid kit must be available at all events.
6. Emergency care at all events must also comply with local community standards.
7. Personnel will be on duty after show hours at show sites where dogs are left overnight.
8. At least one working cellular telephone is required to be on the show grounds during show hours.

The information on the following pages is included to assist clubs who rent the Oriole facility in the development of their required Disaster and Emergency Plan.

Individual Emergencies:

In the event of an urgent medical condition not requiring a call to 911 for immediate transport by ambulance and/or on site treatment by medical personnel, see the following pages for the location of First Aid and AED equipment in the Oriole DTC facility as well as driving instructions to the Emergency Room at St. Agnes's Hospital. Drive time is approximately 5 minutes and their number is 410-368-6000.

Mass Disaster Emergency Plans

If directed to do so by event organizers or in the event the fire alarm and/or sprinkler system activates, all persons are to immediately evacuate by one of the three building exits. Diagrams of these exits are posted throughout the building and are shown on the following pages. Persons should pause only to gather their dogs to take out of the building on leash.

Mobile phones shall be used to call 911.

All persons should be directed to gather at one of the two emergency locations in the parking lot away from the buildings. Diagrams of this location are posted throughout the building and are shown on the following pages. No persons shall re-enter the building until the event organizers are assured by the authorities that it is safe to do so.

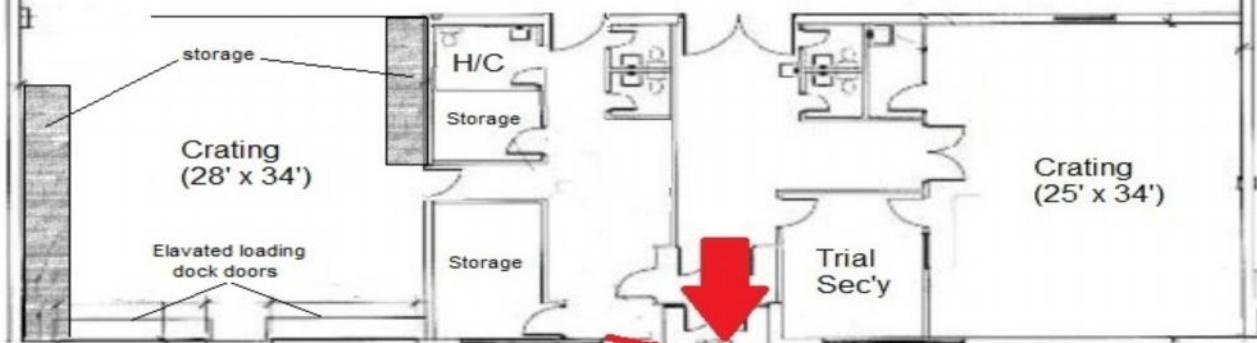
