IMPORTANT: Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct.

You can join the www.NADACForum.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

PLEASE NOTE:

AS OF JANUARY 2014: Dogs must enter the Veterans Division after their 9th birthday. Dogs must entered the Skilled Category, Veterans Division after their 12th birthday.

ALL DOGS ENTERED IN SKILLED ARE REQUIRED TO JUMP 4" LESS THAN THEIR REGULAR JUMP HEIGHT. There is no 20" division for skilled dogs!

Azar Ct and the ODTC building are immediately on your left.

Coming south on I-95 from Baltimore: Take Exit 50B to Caton Ave. Stay right, following signs for Caton Ave N/Wilkens Ave. Merge onto S Caton Ave. After 0.3 miles, turn left onto Benson Ave. After 1.1 miles, turn left into Benson Business Center (Knecht Ave). Azar Ct and the ODTC building are immediately on your left.

Exhibitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of the trial.

*** Dogs must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. Pending numbers are no longer accepted. *** You can register your dog online at www.nadac.com and receive a registration number immediately

The Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, and divisions are included in the current Exhibitors Handbook.

Through submission of entry, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules in the current Exhibitors Handbook.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

The Show Committee has the right to refuse any entry into the trial, including anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC.

IMPORTANT DATES

- Refunds: Entry withdrawals must be received in writing by 5 p.m. on Monday, June 8, 2015, the closing date. A withdrawal from the competition after the closing date due to an injury and/or illness (human/canine) and/or a bitch coming into season, will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid. A doctor/veterinarian's notice of injury or illness will be required for a refund.

Trial Information and Schedule

Move-Ups: Move-ups are available at the trial only on Saturday for Sunday. Paperwork for move-ups will be available at the awards/ribbons table on Saturday. Please be sure to fill out the proper paperwork before leaving on Saturday.

Check in and Measuring will be at 7:15 am. Dogs entered in the Proficient category that are jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16" are required to be measured. Dogs jumping 20" or 20+ are not required to be measured, nor are Veteran or JH dogs that jump 16", nor are Skilled category dogs at any jump height. Dogs with permanent height cards on file do not need to be measured.

Walk through and briefing will begin at 7:45 am on Saturday, and 7:30 am on Sunday.

Judging will begin at 8 am on Saturday, and 7:45 am. on Sunday.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Only the Artful Dodgers "Official Entry Form" and photocopies thereof will be accepted.
- PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR ENTRY IS LEGIBLE. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.
- PLEASE BE SURE TO INCLUDE ALL CORRECT FEES AND REQUIRED INFORMATION ON THE ENTRY
 FORM. Any entry missing required information or does not include correct fees will not be
 processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute valid entry fees. There will be a service charge
 for bank returned checks. (Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in
 his/her being put on a CASH ONLY basis.)
- Express mail entries must include signature release to avoid returned entries. However, express
 mail is not required to enter this trial.
- We will do our best to accommodate those with special parking requirements; however, you must
 have the appropriate official parking permit displayed. Please include a note to the Trial Secretary
 with your entry.

CLUB POLICIES/INFORMATION

- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring.
- Dogs must be appropriately crated or penned when not competing or with their handlers. Dogs may not be left unattended tied to chairs, doors, etc.
- Dogs are not permitted in the restrooms.
- Handlers with more than one dog in a class will be separated if possible.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Any dog and handler not present when they are called will be ineligible to run.
- Electronic timers will be used at this trial.
- There will be no refunds for entries in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such dismissal.
- NADAC Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth places in all jump heights in all classes except Chances. Rosettes will be awarded for those finishing a title.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, natural disaster, weather emergency, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

SITE INFORMATION

- Saturday course-building will begin at 7 am. We would greatly appreciate your help! Exhibitors
 that arrive early to help coursebuild will be given priority at setup time. All other exhibitors will be
 allowed in to set up crates after the competition ring has been set up. The building is NOT open to
 competitors on Friday.
- No cleats of any type may be worn on the turf.
- Crating space is limited. High occupancy x-pens only!
- YOU MUST PROTECT THE FLOOR BY PUTTING SOMETHING WATERPROOF UNDER YOUR CRATES AND CHAIRS). THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED
- Sprint turf requires specialized cleaning and a damage fee for accidents will be levied.
- Crates and chairs may be left overnight; the building is locked but Artful Dodgers is not responsible for security of personal items.
- Dogs may NOT be left overnight.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the show site.
- Please clean up after your dogs! Anyone not doing so at the trial site or hotels will be dismissed from the trial with no refund.
- There is no RV parking onsite.



Categories

- Each class will be split into two categories, Proficient and Skilled.
- A dog may only be entered in ONE category per weekend. The dog must be entered in all Proficient or all Skilled categories for all classes entered on a particular weekend.
- In the **Proficient Category**, dogs must jump their measured jump height per the current jump height table. Runs must be clean, no course faults or time faults.
- In the **Skilled Category**, exhibitors must jump their dog one jump height lower than they are required to jump in the Proficient Category. For example, a dog who measures to jump 20" in the Standard division, Proficient category, must jump 16" in the Standard division, Skilled category and will receive the benefit of the additional time allotted to the 16" dogs. If this same dog is also a Veteran, handled by a Veteran/Disabled Handler, or Junior Handler, he may enter the Veteran or JH Division and jump another 4" lower. This dog would receive the time allotted to the 16" Vets jumping 12".
- As of January 2014, dogs must enter the Veteran's Division after their 9th birthday. Dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division after their 12th birthday.
- Special award plaques and NATCH awards are earned in both the Proficient and Skilled categories.
- Courses are the same for both categories.
- When entering a trial, you must indicate what category you are entering for that weekend. You
 may go back and forth from trial to trial, but not on the same weekend.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here 'NADAC' means North American Dog Agility Council, LLC, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members), Artful Dodgers (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), the Carroll Indoor Sports Center (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
 - 1.6. Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$35.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/we agree to abide by the rules and Regulations of NADAC in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by the board of NADAC for this trial. I/We certify that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or to other dogs. I/We further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above.
