IMPORTANT NOTICE – FROM OUR COMMUNICATIONS DIRECTOR

Dear Members,

On behalf of the Oriole Dog Training Club Board of Directions, I am writing to provide you an update from our most recent Board Meeting, held on May 7, 2020. Our thoughts continue to be with you, your dogs, family, friends, and dog-sport communities as we navigate these challenging times.

The Board continues meeting remotely on a regular basis to assess the impact of COVID-19 on Oriole's operations. As we would typically have our General Membership meeting in late May/June, the Board is planning to host this virtually via Zoom video conferencing. A date for this has not yet been determined. We also want to inform you that regular membership renewal is coming up soon and if you have signed into Club Express, you will see this flag. Lori, our Membership Director, will be sending out more information on this next week.

All agility trials that Oriole originally had scheduled in June 2020 have been cancelled. All scheduled Oriole Events in July 2020 have also been cancelled. The Board continues to monitor the situation and has been proactively planning for a gradual re-opening of the building after the stay at home order has been suspended. The Board also agreed to delay the summer semester by one month, meaning that planning will occur in June if it is deemed feasible to have classes in

the building in the latter half of the summer. The current semester of online classes has been going well overall and the Board is exploring expanding our offering of online classes in obedience, agility, and nosework.

If you haven't already seen them, Oriole has launched three online communities via Facebook to bring our Members together. Scientists are training dogs to identify COVID-19 by following their noses.

COVID 19 – IF YOU HAVE PETS (from the CDC)

Key Points

- CDC is aware of a small number of pets worldwide, including cats and dogs, reported to be infected with the virus that causes COVID-19, mostly after close contact with people with COVID-19.
- Based on the limited information available to date, the risk of animals spreading COVID-19 to people is considered to be low.
- It appears that the virus that causes COVID-19 can spread from people to animals in some situations.
- Treat pets as you would other human family members do not let pets interact with people or animals outside the household. If a person inside the household becomes sick, isolate that person from everyone else, including pets.
- This is a rapidly evolving situation and information will be updated as it becomes available.


