PERFORMANCE DOG PROGRAM AWARDS

I would just like to remind everyone of some changes to our Performance Dog Program.

Back in 1996 when I created this program, there were just a few activities that all breeds could participate in and only a few of those were Oriole activities!

Now, there not only are many more activities that all breeds can participate in but many of those have been adopted as Oriole activities.

I thought it prudent to change the number of activities needed to earn an award in any of our three performance dog levels. The change was made in the beginning of 2021 so those who have earned and submitted applications for 2020 or before will not be affected. Any requests for Performance Dog Awards for 2021 onward will have to abide by the new requirements.

- ---Old requirement for a PD award was 2 activities.....the new requirement is 2 to 3 activities. If you already have a PD pedestal with 2 activities, you will only receive a plate for your existing pedestal if you add a third activity. If you are adding two activities, then you will jump to the next PDX level.
- ---Old requirement for a PDX award was 3 to 4 activities.....the new requirement is 4 to 5 activities. If you already have a PDX pedestal with 3 or 4 activities, you will only receive a plate for your existing pedestal if you add a fourth or fifth activity. If you add a sixth activity, you will jump to the next PDCH level.
- ---Old requirement for a PDCH award was 5 or more activities.....the new requirement is 6 or more. If you already have a PDCH pedestal with 5 activities, you will only receive a plate for your existing pedestal if you wish to add any more activities.

I encourage everyone to at least read the Requirement Sheets on our web site. These sheets explain ALL of the requirements for our various awards programs. If you are interested in our Performance Dog program, I encourage you to read that section of the Requirements Sheets! Also **please** use the appropriate Performance Dog Application if you would like one of these awards.

IT IS ALSO TIME TO GET THOSE APPLICATIONS IN TO EITHER MYSELF (BETTY GARDNER) OR JEAN WILKINS. (Jean handles ALL of the Agility Awards **IF** you are interested in one of our Artful Dodgers agility plaques. These are the plaques with the small agility obstacles on them and small gold tags.) I only handle the agility titles that are to be displayed on one of our Oriole Medallion Plaques and titles earned in any other **Oriole** activity!
