




Trial, he earned another 80 points, placing in two of the four searches and ranking third overall!! So proud of my boy.

I think our prior skills in mastering ORTs at Oriole, use of knowledgeable team members and familiarity of the church from trials was a help in our ability to roll out the ORT at a new location. It was nice to know that we have such a strong team that we can pick up and go anywhere. Our Certifying Official was Donald Grkovich CNWI. The judge was Vinny Catalano CNWI from Coventry School Inc. The host was Dana Hoppes who represented both the church and ODTC. The trial secretary was Linda Grskovich CNWI. The rest of volunteer team were: Sue Cox, Kimberly Culp, Debra Dean, Helena Dahlen, Rosemary Hanes, Debra Kaminski and Linda Miles. Many thanks to them!!

Some of our attendees were new to dog sports. I got compliments on our kindness in providing direction and on our flow. We did 58 runs of either birch, anise or clove. The pass rates were as follows birch 69%, anise 58% and clove 81%.

Treat Your Pup This Holiday Season



Applesauce and Oatmeal Cut-Out Cookies

This is the base recipe for perfect cut-out cookies. You can combine this neutral-colored recipe with the red and green cookie doughs below for dazzling cookie creations, or add natural food coloring to create any color cookies you like.

Prep Time: 10 minutes Cook Time: 20 minutes Total Time: 30 minutes

Yield: 1 tray 1x

Ingredients

2 cups whole wheat flour (you can substitute with regular flour for a whiter dough)

2 cups rolled oat flour

2 eggs

2 tbsp melted coconut oil

1 cup unsweetened applesauce

1 tbsp vanilla extract

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350°.

Combine all ingredients in food processor or stand mixer. Add flour as necessary until dough is no longer sticky and is ready to roll out.

To create doughs of different colors, divide into separate bowls and add natural food coloring. Keep dough covered to prevent drying between batches. You can rehydrate dough with a little coconut oil as needed.

Bake at 350° for 20 minutes and let cool before serving.

Notes: This dough refrigerates up to 1 week, and freezes for 3 months.

Deep Turf Cleaning is Complete!

Capitol Sports Fields (CSF) owned and operated by Gabe Gammill came to our club for project "deep turf cleaning" from November 19 to 21. The job was a bit more than they expected, removing more than four bags of dog hair and fur.

They moved the equipment from side to side, ensuring the edges and corners we clear of debris, filling areas on the field where pitting was noticeable and affecting the dogs running. After cleaning and repairing the turf, the company sprayed disinfectants and applied microbials. These kill most germs, including bacteria, viruses, and fungi, on non-living surfaces.

Let's do our part to keep the turf maintained and clean. Be mindful of throwing treats, especially crumbly ones or treats that can get ground into the turf.

We would like to thank Capitol Sports Fields for their AMAZING work and professionalism throughout the process.
