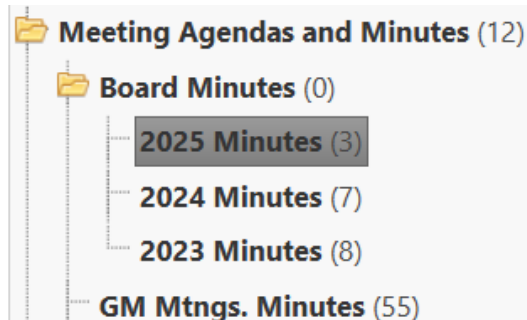

Dianne Harab - Rocky earned his Rally Advanced title on April 4, 2026, at Oriole Dog Training Club in Halethorpe, Maryland.



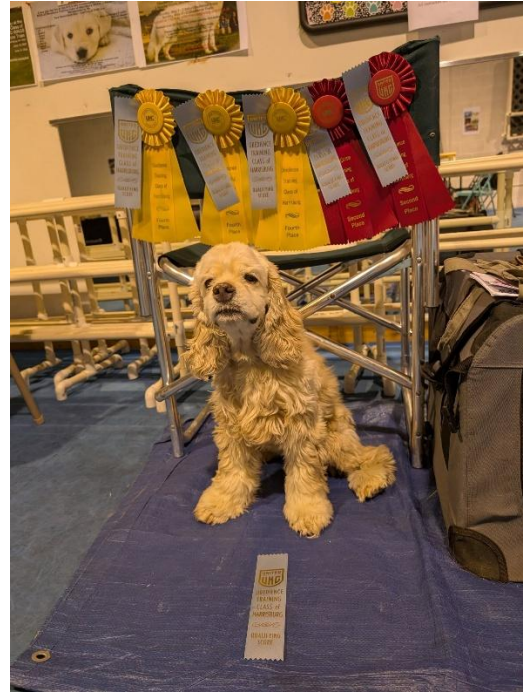

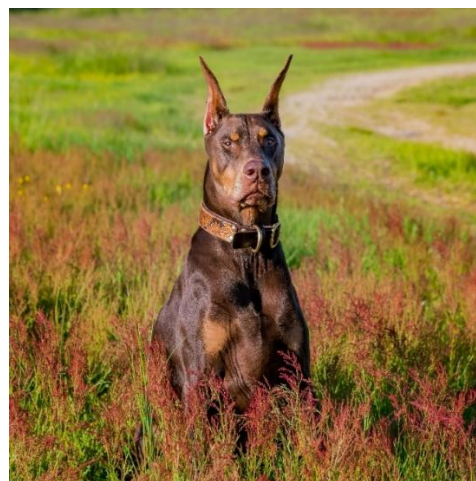
Please extend your sympathy to Janet Gauntt on the passing of Johnny B Goode (Nov 24, 2010 - May 4, 2026). Janet
